If you're homeless or at risk of homelessness, Emmaus Bolton can offer you a home, longer-term support, training, work experience and help to reach your

goals. Our residential community, close to the centre of Bolton, can accommodate up to 22 people at any one time.

We can offer you a private bedroom and access to shared communal spaces; all food and meals prepared each day; toiletries, furniture and clothing, work and training opportunities; tailored support and mentoring to get you back on your feet and a weekly allowance.
