Who we are

We are different to other homelessness services. Founded in 1993, our charity doesn't just offer a bed for the night; we provide a home and meaningful work to up to 17 adults who've experienced or been at risk of homelessness. We take referrals from agencies and individuals - each person is considered on an individual basis.

What we offer

If you contribute to our community and follow the Emmaus guidelines, you will benefit from...

- A single bedroom in our accommodation in the Binley area of Coventry with Wi-Fi, water, gas and electricity.
- A meaningful full-time role, working in one of our social enterprises or helping our homes run smoothly.
- ✓ Three meals a day, 7 days a week.
- 24 hour access to a dedicated support team for specialist advice and guidance.
- Support with accessing NHS healthcare.
- Monthly organised leisure activities.
- Weekly allowance of £40 plus an additional £10 savings contribution.



What we expect

We offer a home for as long as you need it. In return, we expect you to be a part of our community by following our guidelines...

- Be a part of a community, supporting each other.
- Supporting our charity this could be in our charity shop, driving to collect/deliver furniture or food, assisting with our gardening or domestic tasks in our homes.
- Sign off all benefits.
- ☑ Never take drugs and be clean for the last 3 months before arriving.
- Be completely alcohol-free for your first month with us.
- Agree to an alcohol breathalyser test before each work day begins.
- Keep your bedroom clean and tidy.
- Provide a form of ID if possible.
- Be honest on your application form we often accept people with alternative life histories but tell us about them.
