Homelessness charity Emmaus Coventry & Warwickshire is looking for volunteers to help upcycle, repair and restore donated items of furniture. Each piece will then be sold in the Emmaus charity shop, to raise vital funds.



This role is a rewarding opportunity for someone with a creative touch to help breathe new life into old furniture. You'll be working alongside companions (people being supported by Emmaus), in one of two locations in Coventry.

### How you'll help:

- Sort through things that have been donated to our charity, to select items for upcycling, repair or restoration
- Repair and restore furniture items
- Create new products from upcycled materials

### Skills and experience needed:

- Creativity
- Knowledge and experience of upcycling and restoring household goods
- General upcycling skills e.g. painting, woodwork, sanding, DIY
- The ability to assist with lifting heavy items
- Willingness to contribute within a team
- Friendly, with good verbal communication

### Time commitment:

- Upcycling, repair and restoration work usually takes place between 10am and 4pm, Monday to Saturday. There is no set time commitment and we are happy to be flexible to suit the individual.
