We are different to other homelessness services. Founded in 1993, our charity doesn't just offer a bed for the night; we provide a home and meaningful work to up to 26 formerly homeless adults. We take referrals from agencies and individuals - each person is considered on an individual basis.

What we offer

If you contribute to our community and follow the Emmaus Gloucestershire guidelines, you will benefit from...

- A single fully furnished bedroom in our accommodation in the Barnwood area of Gloucester with Wi-Fi, water, gas and electricity.
- A meaningful full-time volunteer role, working in one of our social enterprises or helping our homes run smoothly.
- 24 hour access to a dedicated support team for specialist advice and guidance.
- Food for 3 meals a day, 7 days a week.
- Training opportunities.
- Support with accessing NHS healthcare.
- Weekly volunteer allowance of £46.
- Weekly savings contribution of £10, to help you when you move out.



What we expect

We offer a home for as long as you need it. In return, we expect you to be part of our community by following our guidelines...

- Be a part of the community, respecting and supporting each other.
- Volunteer to work 40 hours per a week within Emmaus Gloucestershire this could be in our charity shop, driving to collect/deliver furniture, online sales or domestic tasks in our community home.
- Sign off all benefits, with the exception of housing benefit and PIP/DLA.
- ✓ Not taking non-prescribed illicit drugs.
- Not dependent on alcohol.
- Keep your bedroom clean and tidy.
- Be honest on your application form we often accept people with alternative life histories but tell us about them.

We take referrals from individuals, homelessness agencies, probation services, and healthcare professionals.
