

Who we are

We are different to other homelessness services. As part of our companionship scheme, we offer a home, work experience and personal development for up to 26 people. We take referrals from agencies and individuals - each person is considered on an individual basis.

What we offer

- A single fully furnished bedroom in our accommodation in the Barnwood area of Gloucester with Wi-Fi, water, gas and electricity.
- A tailored support package for up to 40 hours a week to include work experience within our social enterprise/local businesses, training, qualifications and personal development.
- Access to a dedicated support team for specialist advice and guidance.
- Food for 3 meals a day, 7 days a week.
- Support with accessing NHS healthcare.
- Weekly allowance of £46.
- Weekly savings contribution of £10, to help you when you move out.

What we expect

We offer a home for as long as you need it. Everyone in our Emmaus community follows the following guidelines...

- Be a part of the community, respecting and supporting each other.
- Engagement in our companionship scheme to the best of your ability.
- Not taking non-prescribed illicit drugs.
- Not dependent on alcohol.
- Keep your bedroom clean and tidy.
- Be honest on your application form we often accept people with alternative life histories but tell us about them.
