### Who we are

We are different to other homelessness services. Our charity (based in Hinckley, Leicestershire) doesn't just offer a bed for the night; we provide a home and meaningful work to up to 16 formerly homeless adults. We take referrals from agencies and individuals - each person is considered on an individual basis.

### What we offer

If you contribute to our community and follow the Emmaus guidelines, you will benefit from...

- ☒ A safe and stable place to live that is well maintained. A bedroom (some have an ensuite bathroom) in our shared house in Hinckley - with Wi-Fi, water, gas, electricity and TV, including use of a communal lounge, games room and extensive gardens.
- ☒ Meaningful work in our social enterprise scheme (charity shop, warehouse, van service and online sales).
- ☒ Food for three meals a day, 7 days a week.
- ☒ Personalised support tailored to your individual needs, issues & goals.
- ☒ Training, personal development and learning opportunities.
- ☒ Support with accessing NHS healthcare.
- ☒ Organised leisure activities on request.
- ☒ Weekly allowance plus additional money saved towards your leaving fund (given to you when you move on).
- ☒ Support with getting ID and setting up a bank account if needed.
- ☒ Support and assistance with move on, including support to access housing and future employment when you feel ready.



### What we expect

We offer a home for as long as you need it. In return, we expect you to be a part of our community by following our guidelines...

- ☒ Be a part of a community, supporting each other.
- ☒ Support our charity – this could be working 40 hours a week in our charity shop, driving to collect/deliver furniture, assisting with our online sales or domestic tasks.
- ☒ Sign off all employment related benefits.
- ☒ Be drug (non-prescription) free for the entirety of your stay.
- ☒ Be completely alcohol-free for your first month of arrival.
- ☒ Agree to an alcohol breathalyser test before each workday begins.
- ☒ Keep your room clean and tidy.

Be honest on your application form. We accept people with alternative life histories - tell us about them so we can work with you.
