

Set up an Enthuse page for Emmaus Norfolk & Waveney

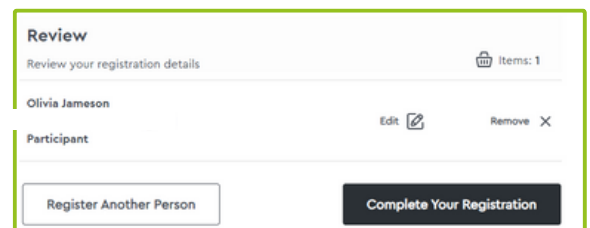


We're here to help you fundraise for our charity!

This guide will support you to set up an enthuse fundraising page and start raising money!

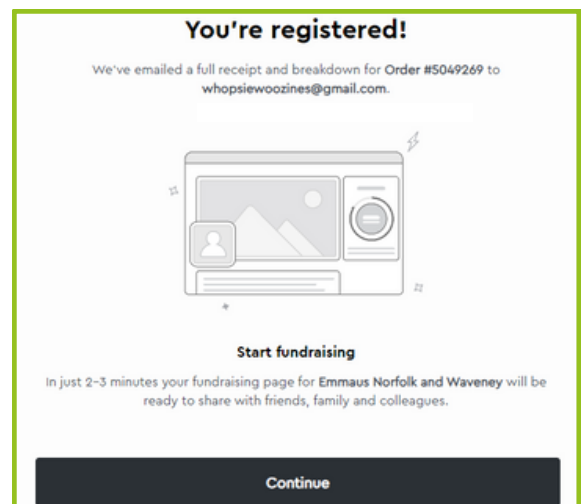
Step 1. Register

- When you have chosen which fundraising challenge you'd like to take part in, click register at the top of the page.
- Here you will fill in some personal details to set up an account with enthuse, choose your entry type, your fundraising target (we recommend a minimum of £250) and have the option to create or join a team.
- After completing these step, just finalise your registration by clicking complete your registration



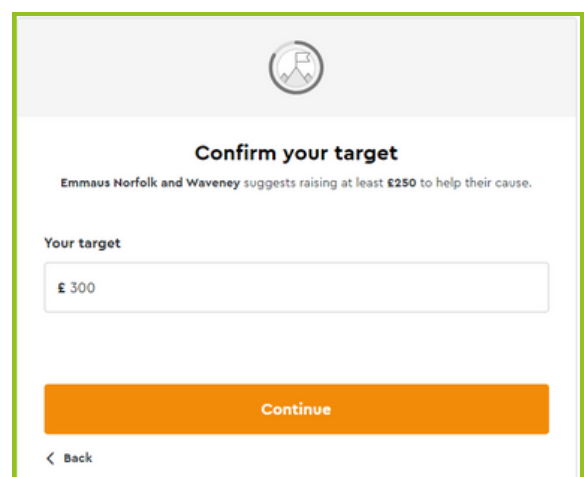
Step 2. Optimise your page

- And you're registered!
- A fundraising page will be automatically sent to your email
- Spend 2 - 3 minutes optimising your page for donations
- Click continue to get started



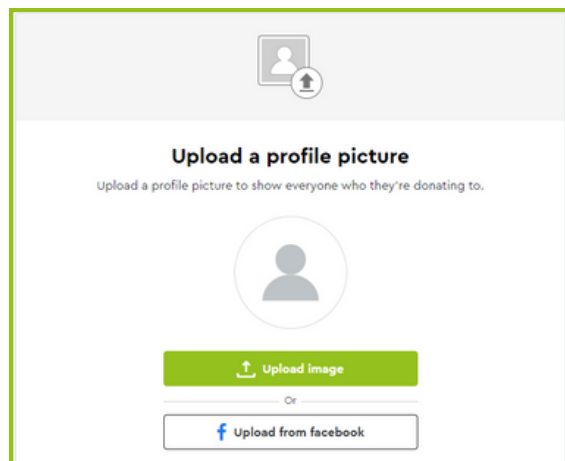
Step 3. Target

- Confirm your fundraising target
- Choose your amount and enter it into the 'Your target' box
- Emmaus Norfolk & Waveney recommend a minimum target of £250 but of course feel free to make this higher!
- Click Continue



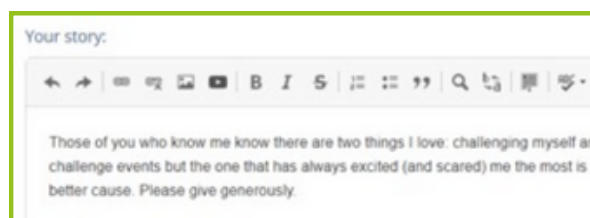
Step 4. Profile Picture

- To add a photo, click either Facebook photo or Upload photo
- The Facebook photo option will use your Facebook profile photo
- Click Continue



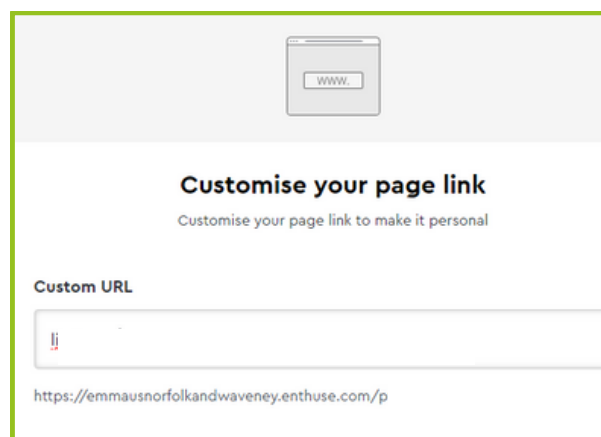
Step 5. Tell your story

- Tell everyone why you're taking part in this event
- This will show up on your fundraising page so make sure to ask people to donate!
- Click continue



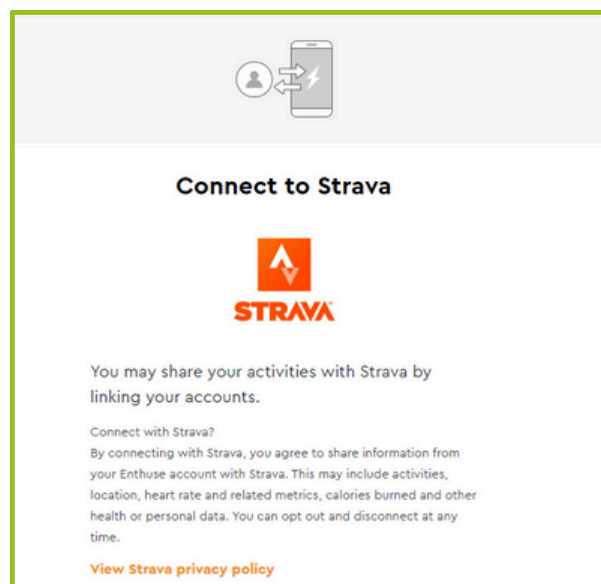
Step 6. Customise your link

- Make your page easier to share and customise your URL
- Use something clear like John-Wellbeing-Challenge
- Click continue




Step 7. Connect Strava

- Keep a track of your walking by connecting your Strava app
- This will let your supporters see how many miles you've walked & will help you get more donations
- If you don't use Strava, don't worry - just skip this step
- Click continue



Step 8. Stay updated


- Choose to opt in or out to emails from Emmaus Norfolk & Waveney
- We'll update you on our B&B and future projects
- We'll never share your data
- Click continue & your done!
