
It has been a difficult year for our charity, and we're asking our supporters to buy Christmas cards to support us.

Darren's story

To mark this year's World Homeless Day and World Mental Health Day, companion Darren is sharing his experience to inspire others:

I was quite young when I began struggling with my mental health. I ended up leaving home but didn't have anywhere to go. I remember my first night sleeping rough even now, 22 years on. I slept in a car park, on the floor. I didn't have anything to sleep on and I was just wearing my jacket. I went on to be homeless on and off for 12 years and sleeping at the side of bypasses and in hedgerows became normal for me.

A lot of the services available to people who are homeless only give you a certain amount of time to stay there. It felt like they were patching over the problem instead of actually solving it. You can only paper over the cracks so much before they start to show again.

I moved to Emmaus Oxford in October 2018 and straight away the team here supported me with my issues and organised counselling sessions. Since joining Emmaus, I have felt my mental health improving each day, which is a great feeling to have.

The recent lockdown was really tough though. I found that my anxiety went up during that period and I missed working in our store. Myself and my fellow companions found other things to do to stay positive like decorating our community home and deep cleaning our shared kitchen. Being at Emmaus Oxford allowed me to keep busy during that time, which really helped.

At Emmaus, I help to run the charity store van service, collecting and delivering furniture for customers. I've also been given the chance to gain some qualifications and have an NVQ Level 2 in Storage and Warehousing. I've not done much of that sort of thing in the past, so it was a great achievement for me.

Emmaus lets you take your time so I know that when I do leave, I'm ready for it. I don't want to go back to hostels or sleeping rough. I'd like to be given the chance to get my own accommodation if I can, and to find work.

Emmaus has helped me progress and achieve things I didn't think were possible. I've finally got a place to call home, for as long as I need it.

We received a fantastic donation of 1,000 face masks, 240 pairs of protective goggles and 120 face shields from a city in Taiwan to help keep our companions safe.

The items were made by disabled or economically disadvantaged women in Tainan City as part of a project that helps them to sell their products to generate their own income. The women are delighted to have the opportunity to export their work overseas and to have friends in Oxford wearing them.

Thanks to receiving such a large donation, we are selling some of the masks on our Depop page. Solidarity is a huge part of Emmaus Oxford and all money raised from the sales will be donated to another local charity so we can help spread the generous support from Tainan even further in Oxford.
