I Choose your game:

Select your game of choice: COD, FIFA, Minecraft or whatever you like to play. Think about how you want to play. Do you want to challenge someone to go head-to-head? Do you want to test yourself and play for a marathon session, 8, 12, 24 hours?





Online fundraising platforms such as <u>JustGiving</u> are easy to use and link directly to your streaming channel. Other platforms include <u>Tiltify</u>, <u>gofundme</u>, <u>wonderful.org</u> and Facebook Fundraising.



3 Stream!

Launch your event, share on your socials, get as many people involved as possible (and have fun).





Top 5 tips for fundraising success

1. Set a target

Let everyone know how much you are raising and how close you are to reaching your target.

2. Make it personal

Tell your story - why are you fundraising for Emmaus? Include photos and regular updates to let people know how you're getting on.



Do something extraordinary. The bigger the challenge the more people will want to support you.

4. Spread the word

Get the word out on social media, tell your friends and family and get people involved - the more the merrier!

5. Stay safe

Whatever your challenge, make sure that you stay safe and know your limits. Take breaks when required - if it doesn't feel like fun you're not doing it right!
